


"Calculations: Units of Measurement"* juried exhibition: small works involving iron as a medium

The Western Cast Iron Art Alliance (wciaa.org) invites artists to apply their quantitative abilities in visual works with reference to the element of iron. Open to small works in all 2D & 3D media. Explorations on archaic, humdrum, or innovative ways to quantify and calculate that might assist in comprehension are welcomed.

Venues: Rudolstadt, Thüringen, July 2022 and Berlin, Germany, September 2022.

Concept

The Western Cast Iron Art Alliance (wciaa.org) seeks visual responses incorporating **Fe** that depict the ways we quantify and calculate to comprehend our place in the world. Mixed media works that explore mathematics, furnace dimensions, postal fees, shipping weight, ancestry, metric, imperial, hand-span, clothing sizes, climate change, statistics, currency, interstellar/ microscopic distances.... and related matters. It seems our entire society is based on units of measurement, from the founding of science to the organization of time. The Western Cast Iron Art Alliance invites artists to apply their quantitative reasoning to visual works of art with reference to the element of iron. How does your world work?

Exhibition Details

This is a mixed media (small works only) international traveling exhibition.

Two venues: Rudolstadt, Thüringen, and at ICCCIA, Berlin, Germany.

Production of a catalogue. Involvement in an international panel discussion.

Artwork must arrive (delivered in person or shipped) in Germany by early summer. Drawings, painting, prints, and sculpture accepted. Iron must be included either as topic or medium.

Artists are responsible for packing, shipping, and insurance of artwork. It will travel to Berlin, September 2022 and return to Rudolstadt where it will be stored for future exhibition possibilities. Artwork can also be collected in person or returned if the artist takes responsibility to ensure return shipping costs and details.

^{*}Inspired by the **elle**, an obsolete unit of measurement last used in Rudolstadt, Germany in the 1870s. The word "ell" literally means "arm" and survives in the modern English word, "elbow" (arm-bend).
