

Frequently Asked Questions for Registration

- 1.) Anyone taking part in the conference has to register. A membership at ICCCIA is suggested and cheaper but not necessary.
- 2.) Relatives and friends traveling with a registered person can purchase event tickets for the Performance Night, the Master of Crafts Sunday and tours or workshops for small money in Berlin. Exhibitions are open for everyone. Panels, workshops and demos are firstly reserved for conference attendees. Space limitations might occur.
- 3.) Generally we try to save free or very cheap accommodation for students. Berlin is a safe city with all-over public transport. So booking.com and Airbnb can deliver hotels, hostels and rooms in the whole city. Best areas to reach the conference sites in Berlin:

 - Köpenick
 - Neukölln
 - Friedrichshain
 - Kreuzberg
 - Schöneberg
 - Mitte
- 4.) Only people who take part actively in the performances should think about staying in Brandenburg, all others should consider the bus shuttle.
- 5.) If you fly to Berlin-Brandenburg-Airport there is a city train to the inner city for a BC-Ticket if you are staying near HTW University or a ABC ticket if in one of the other city areas. For all other city rides you just need AB. So when you know where you are staying we can find out together what kind of transport medium you need and if at all.
- 6.) After Easter there will be a frequent zoom-help-hour you can enter without reservation and during the conference there will be an emergency phone (in the unlikely case you get lost or in trouble)
